Random Drug Screening \$5/sem	\$10.00	<i>Required</i>
ACEMAPP annual fee	\$50.00	<i>Required after acceptance but before registration for MAT courses.</i>
Malpractice Insurance	\$30.00 (\$15/semester)	<i>Due at time of MAT course registration</i>
Health insurance (if not insured)	\$524.00	<i>Annual cost. Personal health insurance accepted. Must provide proof of current insurance.</i>
Certified Phlebotomy Technician Exam	\$125	<i>Due at time of registration.</i>
Health Requirements: (not given at SU) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Physical and immunizations ▪ Immunizations: Tetanus, MMR X2, varicella, annual seasonal flu ▪ PPD skin test- required annually while in program ▪ Hepatitis Injections (series of 3) ▪ Annual Physical Exam 	Varies – approx. \$500	<i>Required <u>after</u> acceptance but before registration for practicum/clinical courses. Immunizations and physical exam not available at SUSCC. Must be obtained from physician’s office or healthcare clinic.</i>
Total estimated cost for Phlebotomy Certificate	\$3,234.00	<i>Does not include cost for health requirements or travel costs to class/clinical.</i>

These costs are an estimate. Your particular costs will vary depending upon whether you have already completed academic courses and have health insurance. The \$524 annual fee for health insurance is only required if you are not covered under a health insurance policy. You are required to submit proof of health insurance coverage before enrolling in courses. The costs for immunizations, blood titers and physical examinations are not included in the total cost. Textbook costs can be reduced by purchasing used or rental books.
