

REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT HEALTH RECORDS

Dear student: Before registering in any health sciences course, you must submit proof of the following items. NO exceptions can or will be made regarding submission of documentation by a medical professional. Turn in your health information to Mrs. Leak in the Health Sciences Building on the Opelika Campus prior to registration. Attach any needed health information to this form.

ITEM	DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED	Faculty Initials
Health Questionnaire (Physical Examination)	<i>Health Questionnaire</i> form must be completed and signed by a physician, physician's assistant, or a nurse practitioner . Health Department stamps are not valid. Health Questionnaire is current for one year from date signed and must be current through the entire term for which student is registering. The annual <i>Health Questionnaire Update Form</i> is available on the SUSCC website or in Health Sciences Department.	
Essential Functions	The Essential Functions form must be signed by student and physician, physician's assistant, or nurse practitioner <u>after</u> admission but prior to registering for courses.	
Drug Screening	Drug screens will be conducted after classes begin by an agency designated by College. <u>Southern Union will issue you a drug screening form.</u> You must have this form in order to have your drug screen done. Random drug screens will be conducted during the program.	N/A
Varicella (Chicken Pox)	Documentation of disease history or immunization. If unable to provide <u>medical</u> documentation, you must have titer (blood test). Attach medical documentation.	
Measles* (Rubeola)	Documentation of <u>two</u> doses of live measles virus vaccine (part of MMR) on or after first birthday. If unable to provide documentation, you must have titer. Attach documentation.	
Mumps*	Proof of two immunizations with live mumps vaccine (part of MMR or MR vaccine) on or after first birthday. Titer is required if no <u>medical</u> documentation of immunization or disease is available. Attach documentation.	
Rubella*	Documentation of two Rubella immunizations (part of MMR or MR vaccines) on or after first birthday. If unable to provide documentation, you must have titer results; if titer is negative, you must repeat immunizations. Attach documentation.	
Tetanus (Td)	Documentation of immunization within last 10 years. Attach documentation.	
Hepatitis B	Documentation of first of series of 3 immunizations is required before registering for first level course. Proof of 2 nd & 3 rd vaccines must be submitted when due. Waiver is available for those unable to receive the vaccine (see Health Sciences Department for waiver). Attach documentation.	
PPD or Tuberculosis (Tb skin test)	Initial Tb skin test is required and must be current during the <u>entire semester</u> . Tb is current for one year from administration date . If you have ever tested positive for Tb, you must submit documentation of a current negative chest x-ray. Chest x-rays are current for 2 years from date of test. MUST ATTACH COPY OF RESULTS.	
Criminal Background Check	Before registration of first health science course(s), students must have a CLEAR status on their criminal background check. Process may take up to 4 weeks for completion. Students returning after more than one semester's absence from program must repeat the criminal background check. NO ONE WILL REGISTER WITHOUT CLEARED BACKGROUND CHECK. Do not use " <u>Pre-check</u> " for your background check. You will need to log on to www.studentbackgrounds.com and submit your personal information and payment of \$100.	
CPR	Documentation of current CPR certification (copy of card) by the American Heart Association, at the Health Care Provider level , must be presented prior to registering for any health science program/course. CPR certification must be maintained throughout entire program. CPR is offered by SUSCC for \$25 fee. Schedules available on web or in Health Sciences Department.	
* Please note: If you require the MMR immunization, you should not be pregnant nor should you become pregnant For three months after receiving the vaccine.		
IMPORTANT: You must attach copies of RESULTS of titers/tests and dates of immunizations. <u>COPIES WILL NOT BE MADE FOR YOU.</u> COPY MACHINES AVAILABLE IN SUSCC LRC/LIBRARY AND STUDENT UNION BUILDING. STUDENT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR KEEPING COPIES OF ALL RECORDS.
