*Qualified applicants for part-time faculty positions in Child Development must have a minimum of a Master's degree in Family and Consumer Science-Child Development concentration or Early Childhood Education with 18 graduate semester or 27 graduate quarter hours in early childhood education. Child Development classes may be held at all three campuses—Opelika, Valley, and Wadley.

Qualified applicants for part-time lab assistant positions must hold a high school diploma or GED and have demonstrated in-field technical skill that exceeds that of the students to be assisted.
