PERFORMING ARTS: SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION APPLICATION DEADLINE MARCH 1

Please read the following instructions carefully. You must submit all required documents by the March 1 deadline in order to be considered for a scholarship.

- You must have submitted to Southern Union an *Application for General Admission* along with your NOTARIZED ID.
- You must have passed ALL parts of the Graduation Exam. Documentation of the graduation exam completion must be verified by your high school principal or counselor in Section B of the scholarship application form.
- You must complete the performing arts scholarship application with the following attachments:
 1. Scholarship Recommendation Form
 2. Copy of high school transcripts
- You may audition for a scholarship in more than one area of performing arts, but you may accept only one scholarship. You must complete an audition request form for each area of performing arts for which you wish to apply. Enclosed you will find request forms for Music, Dance, Theatre, and Technical Support.
- You must contact the director(s) to schedule an audition/interview.

- In addition to the above requirements, you **must** complete a 2012-2013 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) **for Southern Union by March 1, 2012**. Enclosed is a pamphlet to guide you through this process. The website is www.FAFSA.ed.gov. **The school code for Southern Union is 001040**. Failure to include Southern Union's code on your FAFSA could result in the loss of a scholarship opportunity. **To be considered for a scholarship, the FAFSA process is required even if you do not qualify for financial aid.**
