



**DUAL ENROLLMENT / DUAL CREDIT FOR
HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS**

All dually enrolled students must complete the following to be eligible:

- Must be in grade 10, 11, or 12.
- High School Transcript approved by SU Registrar showing a “B” average in completed high school courses.
- Meet the entrance requirements established by Southern Union.
- Submit a SU college application for general admissions and notarized copy of Alabama Drivers License.
- For placement test exemption, provide a copy of ACT or SAT results. If the student has not taken either test or did not score 20 in ENG, 17 in RDG, and 18 in MTH of the ACT or 480 in each section of the SAT, the student will need to take the COMPASS test to ensure proper placement in classes.
- Have written approval from the appropriate principal and the local superintendent of education for each semester. (Complete the following form.)
