



Accelerated High School Program

All Accelerated High School Students must complete the following to be eligible:

- Must have successfully completed the 10th grade.
- Meet the entrance requirements established by Southern Union.
- If your high school is an unaccredited high school, submit a minimum composite score of 16 on ACT or a composite score of 780 on the SAT.
- Submit a SU college application for general admissions.
- For placement test exemption, provide a copy of ACT or SAT results. If the student has not taken either test or did not score 20 in each section (ENG, RDG, or MTH) of the ACT or 480 in each section of the SAT, the student will need to take the COMPASS test to ensure proper placement in classes.
- Enroll only in postsecondary courses for which high school prerequisites have been completed. For example, a student may not take English composition until all required high school English courses have been completed.
- Provide certification from the local principal and/or his/her designee that the student has a minimum cumulative "B" average and recommends that the student be admitted under this policy for each semester. (Complete the following form.)
