APPLICATION DEADLINE MARCH 1

- You must have submitted to Southern Union an *Application for General Admission* along with your NOTARIZED ID and meet all admission requirements. You may apply for admission online at www.suscc.edu.
- You must complete the **performing arts scholarship application** with the following attachments:
 1. Scholarship Recommendation Form
 2. Copy of high school transcripts (an unofficial copy will be accepted)
- You may audition for a scholarship in more than one area of performing arts, but you may accept only one scholarship. You must complete an **audition request form** for each area of performing arts for which you wish to apply. Enclosed you will find request forms for Music, Dance, Theatre, and Technical Support.
- You must contact the director(s) to schedule an audition/interview.
