

(Re)Engage ALABAMA

Interested in returning to school to finish your degree? You may qualify for the new (Re)Engage Grant provided by the Alabama Commission on Higher Education. Limited funds and program eligibility available. Check out the requirements listed below and contact us today for more info.

1. Age, 22 years or older.
2. A citizen or a lawful permanent resident of the United States.
3. A resident of Alabama.
4. A graduate of a secondary school or the recognized equivalent of a high school graduate.
5. Has not attended a postsecondary education institution for at least two (2) years (24 consecutive months) prior to their current enrollment.
6. Has not earned an associate or baccalaureate degree at any other institution prior to applying for the (Re)Engage Alabama Grant Program.
7. Classified as an undergraduate student with the completion of at least 36 credit hours for an associate degree or at least 72 credit hours for a baccalaureate degree.
8. Enrolled as a part-time (minimum of six (6) semester hours) student in an eligible program in an authorized institution leading to an associate degree or baccalaureate degree that is aligned with Alabama's high demand workforce needs promulgated by the Alabama Committee on Credentialing and Career Pathways.
9. Has good academic standing as defined by the institution.
10. Has a completed FAFSA
11. Not enrolled in a course of study leading to an undergraduate degree in theology, divinity, or field of preparation for a religious vocation.
12. Is enrolled in courses of study directly leading to a degree identified in alignment with a job on the ACCCP list of high demand programs as determined by the funding process developed by ACHE
