Students who have an ACT score of 30-34 in English or a SAT Verbal score of 680 to 710 are exempt from English 101. Students who have an official ACT score in English of 35-36 or a SAT Verbal score of 720 or greater will receive credit for English 101 and 102. ACT scores may not be more than five years old.
