

# **ENGLISH Exemption Guidelines**

Any student scoring at or above the established ACT or SAT score for either English/Writing or Reading within five years of enrollment is exempt from the subject specific placement assessment and is eligible for English 101.

**GED** – Students who score ≥ 165 on the Reasoning Through Language Arts subject tests of the 2014 series GED are eligible for English 101.

#### **ENGLISH 101 and ENGLISH 102 Course Credit**

Students who have an ACT score of 30-34 in English or a SAT Verbal score of 680-710 are exempt from English 101. Students who have an official ACT score in English of 35-36 or a SAT Verbal score  $\geq$  720 will receive credit for English 101 and 102. ACT scores may not be more than five years old.

## **MATH Exemption Guidelines**

Any student scoring at or above the established ACT or SAT score for Math within five years of enrollment is exempt from the subject specific placement assessment and is eligible for courses based on high school math completed.

**GED** – Students who score ≥ 165 on the Mathematical Reasoning subject tests of the 2014 series GED are eligible for Math 112.
