

Attention students who are planning to transfer to Auburn in **Forestry**

- Forestry students are required to attend **Summer Practicum** traditionally between their sophomore and junior years.
- Forestry students must apply and be accepted for the **Summer Term** in order to attend practicum. It is recommended they apply before **March** so they receive all relevant communication leading up to practicum.
- Before attending Summer Practicum, students must have completed ENGL 1101 & 1102, BIO 1020/21 & 1030/31, MATH 1130 or above, and STATS 2510.
- Summer Practicum is ten credit hours and lasts eight weeks. Students are responsible for tuition and fees associated with attending.
