Attention students who are planning to transfer to Auburn in **Forestry**

- Forestry students are required to attend **Summer Practicum** traditionally between their sophomore and junior years.
- Forestry students must apply and be accepted for the Summer Term in order to attend
 practicum. It is recommended they apply before March so they receive all relevant
 communication leading up to practicum.
- Before attending Summer Practicum, students must have completed ENGL 1101 & 1102, BIO 1020/21 & 1030/31, MATH 1130 or above, and STATS 2510.
- Summer Practicum is ten credit hours and lasts eight weeks. Students are responsible for tuition and fees associated with attending.
