Effective 10/15/2020, a signed certificate validating successful completion of a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) course is a requirement for the Paramedic to ADN Mobility program application. Students who apply for the Paramedic to ADN Mobility program option are no longer required to obtain the Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) certification.

Admission to the Associate Degree Nursing Mobility program for paramedics requires:

- a. Applicant meets all nursing program general admission requirements
- b. An unencumbered or non-restricted license as a Paramedic in Alabama
- c. Signed certificate validating successful completion of a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) course
- d. Submission of application for the Paramedic to RN Mobility option
- e. Completion of prerequisite general education courses with a minimum grade of "C"

Courses are:

- BIO 201 Human Anatomy and Physiology I (4 credit hours)
- BIO 202 Human Anatomy and Physiology II (4 credit hours)
- ENG 101 English Composition (3 credit hours)
- SPH 107 Fundamentals of Public Speaking (or SPH 106)
- MTH 100 Intermediate College Algebra or higher level
- PSY 210 Human Growth and Development (3 credit hours)

Total Prerequisites = 20 credit hours
