Competitions

There is a competition for IA – IIIA and private school division competition on one day and a competition for IVA – VIIA school division on a second day. There is an Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Precalculus, and Comprehensive competition on each day. There are 4 members per team. Each competition consists of two parts, a written test and ciphering questions. The written tests are timed lasting one and one-half hours and consist of 30 multiple choice questions. The students will have one and one-half minutes to complete each of the 3 ciphering questions. The Alabama Course of Study is referenced when creating questions.

Time and Location

The competition is held on the Wadley Campus during April. Registration begins at 8:15 am and the competition ends around 2:00 pm. Lunch is provided.

Cost

The cost is \$5 per team member.

Rules

In order to compete in the Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, and Precalculus competitions, a student must be currently enrolled in that course or have completed that course this school year. A student can only compete in each competition once. **No calculators may be used.**

Awards

Two **FULL** tuition scholarships are awarded to the top scoring senior who plans to attend Southern Union. Individual and team awards in each category are also presented.
